### **LOCAL CONTESTS FOR PLUMBING, PIPEFITTING, SPRINKLER FITTING, WELDING AND HVAC TECHNICIANS**

**PARTICIPANTS** – Participants in a local contest shall be **apprentice** members of Local Unions of the United Association (UA) according to the records which are on file in the General Office of the UA. **A contestant must have been employed by a contributing contractor for at least 1500 hours in the previous 12 months as verified by fund office contribution reports.**

**DRUG TESTING** — All Candidates must be in compliance with their local unions drug policy as defined within their collective bargaining agreement at the time of their local's apprenticeship contest, if applicable.

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### **STATE/PROVINCIAL CONTESTS FOR PLUMBING, PIPEFITTING, SPRINKLER FITTING, WELDING AND HVAC TECHNICIANS**

**PARTICIPANTS** – Participants in a State/Provincial contest shall be members of Local Unions of the UA, and shall be a winner of a Local Union contest. **A contest participant shall be an apprentice while competing in their State/Provincial contest.** The second and third place winners of a local contest may be the first and second alternates, respectively, and may enter a State/Provincial contest only if the first place winner is unable or does not wish to participate. Contest participants may be required to show their dues card to the contest committee as proof of membership in the UA. Only one contestant from each craft in any local union may enter the state or provincial contest.

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### **REGIONAL CONTESTS FOR PLUMBING, PIPEFITTING, SPRINKLER FITTING, WELDING AND HVAC TECHNICIANS**

**PARTICIPANTS** – All participants in a regional contest shall be members of Local Unions of the UA, and shall be a winner of a state or provincial contest. The second and third place winners of a state or provincial contest may be the first and second alternates, respectively, and may enter a regional contest only if the first place winner is unable or does not wish to participate. Contest participants may be required to show their dues card to the contest committee as proof of membership in the UA. Only one contestant from each craft in any state or province may enter the regional contests.

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### **INTERNATIONAL CONTESTS FOR PLUMBING, PIPEFITTING, SPRINKLER FITTING, WELDING AND HVAC TECHNICIANS**

**PARTICIPANTS** – All participants in the international contest shall be members of Local Unions of the UA, and shall be a winner of a regional contest. Before a contestant participates in the international contest, their eligibility shall have been verified in accordance with the rules governing participation in the local union, state/provincial and regional contests. Any individual may participate in the International Apprenticeship Contest providing that they were registered with the United Association as an apprentice on the last day of the State Contest. Only one contestant from each of the **five** crafts in each of the six regions may enter the international contest for a total of 30 contestants. If for any reason the winner in a regional contest cannot attend, the selection of the alternate will be by the next highest score.
